# 2020 – 2021 BUDGET/TREASURER'S REPORT

#### **District Funding and Support**

The district continues to pay for some release time for those coordinating events. The district also pays for supplying championship material such as wristbands, rosettes, and ribbons for our playdays and events. We continue to be supported by our district and we are thankful for their financial involvement.

#### SESAA Account

Our bank account continues to be in a healthy position (as shown below). This account is funded by the annual school levy of \$100.00 per school. We typically use this account to cover release time for event coordination, coaching recognition awards, AGM expenses, and on-going expenses such as starter caps and equipment for track meets and other sports that require additional equipment to operate. Our current balance is high due to COVID-19 and the significant impact it has had on SESAA activities and events since March 2020. As we head into the 2021/2022 school year, our executive is of the view that we should NOT request the annual school levy from the district. We may request a partial levy mid-year, if the COVID-19 situation lifts and activities resume normally.

Normally, we try and keep a healthy balance of at least \$5,000.00 from year to year. This balance will be used when emergencies arise which might include: needing more release days, purchasing equipment for sports, buying additional bracelets, etc.

#### **Changing Banks**

At the 2020/2021 SESAA AGM, it was approved that we would change our bank from Van City to Toronto Dominion Bank with the following authorized to make the changes with the banks: Treasurer, Vice President, and or the President of SESAA. Due to COVID-19, we have held off on making this switch. We plan to make this switch when the COVID-19 situation lifts.

#### Motion for School Levy 2021/2022

The school athletic levy will not be requested for 2021/2022 with plans to resume our normal request of \$100 per school in 2022/2023. A partial levy may be requested 2021/2022 should SESAA activities and events resume mid-year.

Motion: Haley Workun – Treasurer

**<u>Rationale</u>**: We have a significant surplus due to the cancellation of most SESAA activities and events this school year. Should activities resume this upcoming school year, SESAA may request a partial levy.
