This year's play day format will again have groupings of three and four school sites. The attempt was made to keep teams close to their original conference to limit travel time. The host school and the coach of that team should contact the visiting schools to provide any details. If there is a conflict with gym availability, the competing school's coaches are asked to arrange an alternate date or site. I was able to choose mostly volunteering schools to host, but 3 schools had to be chosen at random.

Teams will have only 8 players for the tournament; substitutions may be made in the case of injuries. Refer to the SESAA handbook for rule clarification (p. 50-53).

Please have new shuttles available for the games.

Bookmarks for the competing athletes and a First-Place rosette will be delivered to host schools.

Winner is the team with most wins. If tied, most points between tied teams.

Hosts may adjust the time length of games to reduce the overall time of the playday.
